The CCC procures its IT services from the Department for Environment and Rural Affairs (Defra) and the following response has been provided by them:

The information you have requested is not held by Defra. Due to the way this information is held within our systems, we are unable to separate out CCC data. We are also only able to provide 3 months' worth of data and therefore cannot provide this data by year.
