- Is the "Climate Change Committee" currently and/or over the last two years been involved in or responsible for instructing a military/civilian/department/committee and/or agency in the United Kingdom or any other country to inject aerosols into the atmosphere over the UK?
- 2. Why is this being done?
- 3. What exactly is being sprayed?
- 4. What type of equipment is being used to transport and spray the aerosols into the atmosphere?
- 5. Who gave permission for this to be done?
- 6. How much does it cost to do this and who is funding it?
- 7. Why is this information not in the public domain?
